| How were the beneficiaries selected? | After finishing the settlement level planning, The village committee organized the meeting and made the decisions to distribute the money. Generally the villager followed some indicators for the distribution of money which is indicated by LGCDP(Local Government Community Development Program): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The family with no or very little land. • Poor house condition. • Lack of food for whole year. • Labors for others for livelihood. • Unemployed family. • No guarantee for settlement, etc. |

| Impact of Settlement level planning | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Villagers have applied for 2 the projects from VDC and DDC, but almost the money went for earthquake support, so this time this is not possible to get support for the project applications from the village. . |
| Village situation after Earthquake and aftershock | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All the houses are totally collapsed. The school building also cracked and it is difficult to teach inside the room. IT building also partially cracked. Many livestock sheds are cracked and damaged. People are requesting more shelter but the VDC distributed very few due to the limitation of funds. |
