

# REPORT FROM ASK/TRIANGLE

## NP-44 DAHA TOLE

### GANDAKI PROVINCE - SYANGJA NEPAL



**Raju Paudel - 38 year young man, NP-44, Daha Tole Syangja** joined the Triangle Support Project last year. His life was very hard. They have no permanent income, 2 children to send to school and care for his old aged father and mother. They have very little land and traditional agriculture system has not been able to provide enough food for a year.

With the support of Triangle grant he obtained NRs 10,000 through the village committee microloan without any interest, which he used to purchase 2 pregnant goats from the locality. After a few months one of the goats died but another gave three kids and he started to rear. Within one year he already sold 2 goats worth NRs 14,000 and recently he has 2 goats again.

His income is increasing and he is not suffering from small type of financial crisis (food, clothes medicines for father and mother) and to handle his household economy. Regarding change, Raju replied "I do not need to knock on the local money lender's door for loans anymore and happy because the Triangle and the donors are giving us, the poor and young citizens priority"

## 5. Activity Plan

### 5.1 Responsible for the implementation

The village committee plays the vital role to implement all activities. After that the rural municipality's ward Secretary, the social mobilizer of ASK, the rural municipality social mobilizer and the Triangle responsible person Hari and Lekhnath also supports in implementing and monitoring.

## 5.2 Any proposals submitted to the Municipality or District and approved

3 projects were supported from government side (2 by municipality and 1 by central government):

- Irrigation pound conservation (Barahsthan).
- Patlako Dil drinking water conservation.
- Commercial chilly/vegetables farming.

## 5.3 Villagers own initiative

The villagers have to contribute a minimum 20% cash/ kind (unskilled labor) as per the rules of the government of Nepal for supported projects as the above, which was done. All committee members worked voluntarily for Triangle support activities.

## 6. How were beneficiaries selected?

After finishing the settlement level planning the village committee's members organized another meeting and established criteria for the distribution of money. Generally, the villagers followed priorities for the distribution of money used by LGCDP (Local Government Community Development Program) indicators:

- Families with no or very little land
- Needy people
- Poor housing conditions and Lack of food for the whole year
- Persons with labor-based livelihoods (for others)
- Unemployed families and needy people
- No guarantee for settlement and most earthquake affected persons.

<p><b>7. Ongoing activities update, results of the activities from Donor funding in 2017</b></p> <p>All planned activities were completed. From the grant Nrs 75000.00 (DKK 5000), Nrs 70000.00 invested for micro loan to women, poor and needy people for different income generation activities and benefited 7 families and remaining Nrs 5000.00 is in bank as per rule of bank. Out of 7 families;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 families got a microloan of Nrs 20000.00 (2 persons*Nrs 10000.00) and have started commercial and off season/seasonable vegetables farming.</li> <li>• 5 families got a microloan of Nrs 40000.00 (4 persons*Nrs 10000.00) and have started raising of goats (Nrs 30000.00 from this year and remaining microloan covered from last year repaid).</li> </ul>

(Learning)</b></p> <p><b>Public Social Audit:</b> We have to learn.</p> <p><b>Community Score Cards:</b> We need to know and want to improve our health post and school.</p> <p><b>Right to Information:</b> We heard but not aware how to use.</p> <p><b>Other methods (SLP):</b> This is a very good and participatory method to know the planning system and the selection of most needed projects. The villagers are now committed to do the SLP themselves with small help.</p>
<p><b>9. Micro finance update</b></p>
<p><b>9.1 Money collected in the fund for microloan generated from Danish donor funding</b></p> <p>The fund for providing microloans has increased over the last years. Apart from the 70,000 NRS from 2017, a sum of 50000 Nrs paid back from previous years was added to make 100000 NRS for distribution in 2017/018. The 5 families, who got the micro loan for goat raising and vegetables farming in 2016 have got the benefits and successfully repaid loans amounting to 50000 Nrs.</p>
