*There is not any income source in the house. He has 4 children they went to town for better opportunity but never want to back home.*

*Time is running and life is now converted into old age. He has to pass another many years with alive. So, to keep alive, Tirtha has an idea to do the organic vegetables farming/tomato farming at the middle of the hillside.*

*For his activeness, Triangle village committee gave a micro loan of Nrs 10000.00 without any interest. He has planted cucumber, beans, lady fingers, chili and tomatoes with the technical support of ASK Nepal and village committee last year. When the crops started to give income he became very happy. He has earned Nrs. 15000.00 already and now he has more vegetables to sell which will earn more than Nrs 20000.00.*

*So, he is being one of the old model farmers in the village and every one praised him. He says with a smile, 'this is possible by the help of Triangle support program for the poor and needy people'.*

- Irrigation project at Dihi Chhapatari
- Irrigation pipe purchase at Paniko Pakha
- Drain construction near Megha Bahadur home

### 5.3 Villagers own initiative

The villagers have to contribute a minimum 20% cash/ kind (unskilled labor) as per the rules of the government of Nepal for supported projects as the above, which was done. All committee members worked voluntarily for Triangle support activities.

<p>After finishing the settlement level planning the village committee's members organized another meeting and established criteria for the distribution of money. Generally the villagers followed priorities for the distribution of money used by LGCDP(Local Government Community Development Program)indicators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Families with no or very little land</li> <li>• Needy people</li> <li>• Poor housing conditions and lack of food for the whole year</li> <li>• Persons with labor-based livelihoods (for others)</li> <li>• Unemployed families and needy people</li> <li>• No guarantee for settlement and most earthquake affected persons.</li> </ul>

The grant Nrs 75000.00 (DKK 5000), Nrs 70000 was invested for micro loan to women, poor and needy people for different income generation activities which benefited 7 families and Nrs 5000.00 is in bank account of village as per the rule of bank. 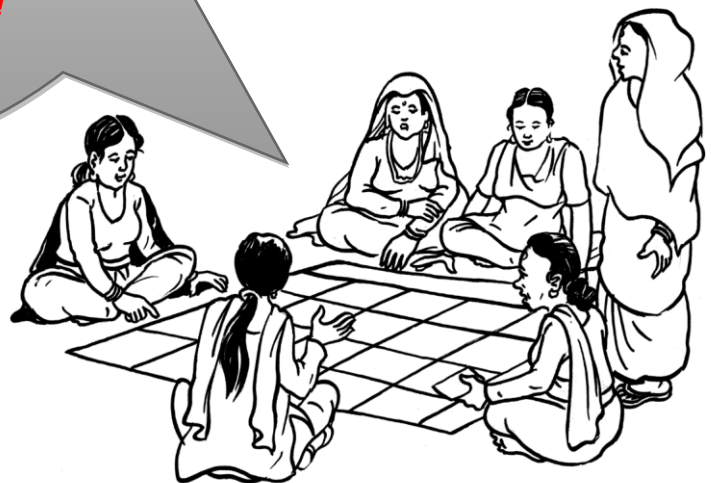
## Message from Village.....
