

# REPORT FROM ASK/TRIANGLE

## NP-27 TIKAJA BHUJUNGE

### GANDAKI PROVINCE - SYANGJA NEPAL

Most significant change/postcard



**Sita Devi Dhakal - 65-year-old poor widow from NP-27 Tikaja Bhujunge, Syangja** joined the Triangle Support Project last year. Her life was very hard. She has no income so it is difficult to manage the food because her very little land with traditional agriculture system has not been able to provide enough.

With the support of Triangle grant she obtained a Nrs 10,000.00 micro-loan through the village committee without any interest, which she used to purchase two pregnant goats from the locality. Within few months those goats gave another two kids and again pregnant. Now she has confidence that those 2 kids will earn nearly Nrs 20000.00 after few months and she will repay the loan and use some money for food and clothes. She was so happy and told "now it is possible to survive easily because of the Triangle and Danishl donor support me".

<p>After finishing the settlement level planning the village committee's members organized another meeting and established criteria for the distribution of money. Generally the villagers followed priorities for the distribution of money used by LGCDP (Local Government Community Development Program) indicators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Families with no or very little land</li> <li>• Needy people</li> <li>• Poor housing conditions and Lack of food for the whole year</li> <li>• Persons with labor-based livelihoods (for others)</li> <li>• Unemployed families and needy people</li> <li>• No guarantee for settlement and most earthquake affected persons.</li> </ul>
